About the courses

SELIC Cambridge Test Preparation Courses teach all the language skills, with emphasis on:

ABOUT THE EXAMINATIONS

Cambridge General Certificate Examinations

FCE – First Certificate in English

- *Upper Intermediate*

FCE is the most popular of all the Cambridge examinations. It is for students who can use English confidently in a variety of situations and is proof of ability to do office work or take a course of study in English. The examination consists of five papers: Reading, Writing, Use of English, Listening and Speaking.

CAE – Certificate in Advanced English

- *Advanced*

CAE is an increasingly popular examination for students at advanced level who may need English for work at a professional or managerial level or who want to follow a course of academic study at university level. It is a very practical exam with five papers testing all the skills.

CPE – Certificate of Proficiency in English

- *Advanced*

CPE is a very advanced examination for students whose level is approaching that of an educated native speaker. It is proof of ability to cope with a high level of academic work. The course is suitable for those who have a wide vocabulary, enjoy literature and a range of other reading material, and can talk fluently about any topic.
