## Airport Options

These are some options you may want to consider if you are flying in or out of Sydney:

### Taxis

Taxis are a handy option for those who would like direct and easy transport. The cost to and from the airport, from the city or Eastern Suburbs, is approximately \$30-\$50. There are sheltered taxi ranks at each terminal, with supervisors on hand during peak times.

### Airport Link Railway

The airport link railway stations provide direct access to/from both the domestic and international terminals. The trip to Bondi Junction from the international terminals takes about 30 minutes, and the cost starts at \$11.80 one-way. ## SELC Airport Transfer

Students with an accommodation booking made through SELC, can request a SELC airport transfer. The cost is \$110 (2005) one way (from airport to accommodation).

SELC requires the flight arrival details as early as possible including:

- date
- flight number
- arrival time

SELC's airport representative will meet the student at the arrival gate and will be displaying this sticker.

**Government buses (number 400, 353)**

These are normal government buses that travel between the airport and Bondi Junction. They are frequent, although the travelling time is usually longer as it is a normal bus service rather than an express. Although the cost is cheap (approximately \$4), it may not be a practical option for people with large amounts of luggage.
